All applicants, co-signers and spouses will need to receive a class certificate.

Housing counselors are available to provide useful information to help homeowners prevent foreclosure. To apply to speak with one of our housing counselors for FREE you must complete and return the intake application.

MONEY MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE

Extension services offers a variety of resources, materials and classes covering positive money management techniques to help individuals and families adapt to tough economic times. Education offerings include: managing debt, credit counseling and repair, financial literacy education, budgeting, money saving tips and money management for teens.

OSCEOLA COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES

Indigent Cremation Program:

Social services administer the indigent cremation program for deceased persons who died within the geographical boundaries of Osceola County. The county will cover the cost of cremation and burial will be provided for unidentified bodies or any other situation, in a case by case basis. Payment under this program will be made only if there are absolutely no other resources available to cover these costs.

Section 8:

The Section 8 program provides assistance for low income families in the private rental market through the Housing Assistance Payment Program. *housing@osceola.org*

Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation:

Assists homeowners with repairs to bring their home to building code and make them decent, safe, and sanitary.

Rental Security and Utility Deposits:

Assists eligible residents in danger of becoming homeless as a result of the inability to pay security and/or utility deposits when seeking residence in rental housing.

Community Development Block Grant:

The Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 established the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to provide decent housing, suitable living environment, and expanded economic opportunities for persons of low and moderate income. The grant funds are currently being used to provide rental assistance, façade/infrastructure improvement grants, and after hours health services. Please contact our office for more information on the program and/or how to apply for assistance.

Homeless Advocate:

Tasked with providing comprehensive assistance and liaison services on behalf of homeless individuals and families living in Osceola County through special projects related to homelessness, transitional housing efforts, and grant development. Services include crisis intervention, rental assistance, prevention and overall coordination of homeless issues for Osceola County. homesless@osceola.org


