

## Stay Informed During an Emergency

AlertOsceola is Osceola County's public safety warning system capable of notifying Osceola County residents of an immediate emergency. Registration for AlertOsceola is free, and allows public safety officials to notify you of emergencies such as a missing person, road closures, hazardous materials spill, law enforcement advisories, and wildfire, tornado, and flood warnings issued by the National Weather Service.

AlertOsceola is only used for emergency purposes by authorized public safety officials.
